



HOW TO MAKE AN ORIGAMI HANK!

**Craft your own Paws Of Fury hero...
A samurai pooch in eight easy steps!**

There's loads to love about new animated adventure *Paws Of Fury: The Legend Of Hank*. It's a super-stylish splash of swordplay and belly laughs, as Hank – a dog with zero combat experience – is enlisted as a samurai to defend the cat town of Kakamucho. But maybe best of all is the stunning origami in the movie, paper-based creations as beautiful as they are fun. Here's how you can make your very own Hank.




1 Fold a square piece of origami paper (regular A4 won't do) in from both sides, then fold the paper back out again so that it lies flat on the table.




2 Make sure your paper is laid out in a diamond shape (with the pointy end at the top). Make two creases as shown in the right and left edges.



3 Fold your two edges inwards. Then fold just the tip of the left edge (Hank's nose) back under and make a crease in the right edge (his tail).



4 Now make a crease across the middle, horizontally, and fold the right edge in and then back out on top of itself, to form the tip of Hank's tail.



5 Close your piece of paper vertically, bringing your top tip down in line with your bottom tip, forming an envelope you can open out.



6 Fold the paper up from the bottom, in the direction of the arrow shown here, exposing the inside. Flip the paper and repeat the process.



7 Pull down the top outside edges of the paper on both sides, forming Hank's body and exposing his head and tail ends. You are nearly there!



8 For your finishing touches, use a brown pen to color in Hank's head and tail and a yellow one for his robe. Add on two eyes... and admire!
