THE CROP CIRCLES



THE BERMUDA TRIANGLE

The Bermuda Triangle, also known as 'The Devil's triangle', is a 305,000 square kilometre area of the Atlantic Ocean where the disappearances of ships, airplanes, and boats has led to the belief that "supernatural" forces live in this area of the sea. THE LOST CITY OF ATLANTIS


Atlantis is a name for a large island kingdom that supposedly had been in the Atlantic Ocean many years before it sank into the depth of the sea and vanished within a day and a night!

Not all mysteries date back to ancient times, in 1980 an anonymous group commissioned the construction of a granite monument in Elbert County, Georgia, in the United States. The large slabs were engraved with guidelines on rebuilding the earth, possibly meant for after an apocalyptic event. To date, the identity of the group responsible for the Georgia Guidestones remains a mystery.
